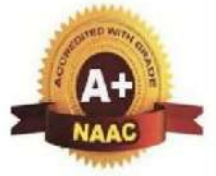




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'International Yoga Day'

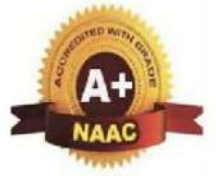
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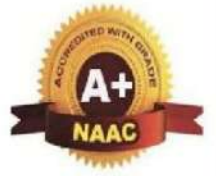
‘Training Program on Electrical Safety’

Shriram (Electrical Inspector), Shri. R. Kumbhar (Assistant Engineer), Shri. Yogesh Satpute (Assistant Engineer) and Shri. Shanoor I. Fakir (Assistant Engineer) were the chief guests and speakers also. Ms. Shrimanti Rokade gave the preface in which she explained that Electricity is a major aspect of human being’s day to day life. Equally important is the Electrical safety for each one of us. Hence we need to understand the types, applications, fatals occurring and care to be taken. Electrical safety is crucial in both residential and industrial settings, as improper handling of electrical systems and equipment can lead to severe consequences. The experts gave us a review of Electrical Safety and precautions to be taken while handling Electrical equipments. Here are some key principles and tips for electrical safety discussed by the Electrical Inspector along with his team.

1. **Use Qualified Professionals:** Always hire licensed electricians for electrical installations, repairs, and maintenance to ensure that work is done safely and up to code.
2. **Inspect Electrical Cords:** Regularly check power cords and plugs for any signs of wear, fraying, or damage. Replace damaged cords immediately.
3. **Avoid Overloading Outlets:** Do not overload power outlets or power strips with too many devices. This can lead to overheating and fire hazards.
4. **Keep Water Away:** Keep electrical appliances and cords away from water sources to prevent electrocution.



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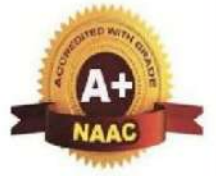
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Tree Plantation

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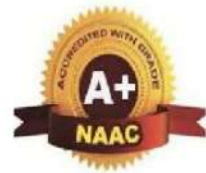
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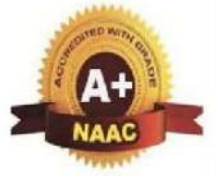
Personality Development

The summary of the session is as follows.

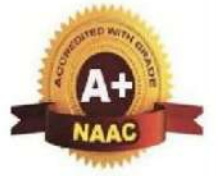
Snake Awareness: Snake awareness involves educating the public about snake species, their habitats, behaviours, and potential dangers. This knowledge empowers individuals to take appropriate precautions and actions when encountering snakes. Some key points of snake awareness include...

1. Identification: Teach people how to identify venomous snakes commonly found in the area. This can include recognizing distinctive markings, head shape, and other identifying characteristics.
2. Habitats: Inform people about snake habitats. Snakes can be found in various environments, such as grasslands, forests, deserts, and wetlands.
3. Behavior: Educate the public about snake behavior. Most snakes are not aggressive and will try to avoid humans. However, they might become defensive if they feel threatened.
4. Precautions: Advise individuals to wear appropriate footwear and clothing when in snake-prone areas, such as high boots and long pants. Encourage them to be cautious when stepping over rocks or logs and to avoid reaching into areas where they can't see.
5. Avoidance: Teach people how to back away slowly if they encounter a snake. Quick movements and loud noises can agitate snakes.
6. First Aid: Provide basic knowledge of snakebite first aid, such as keeping the affected limb still, keeping the person calm, and seeking medical attention immediately.

At a glance, Snakes are creatures that play important roles in ecosystem around the world. Some snakes are harmful while most are harmless.

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Disaster management

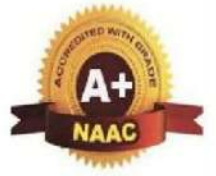
Another very informative, useful and much needed session on Disaster management was conducted. Entire team of eight from Fire Station Baramati had arrived for the same. The leader of the team Mr. Sunil Ingawale shared some previous unfortunate incidences and also the subsequent remedies to avoid these in the form of presentations and videos in a lucid manner. During the afternoon session, he and his team gave live demonstration of how to bring in control the fire. The glimpses of the combined sessions are as follows.

Disaster management refers to the process of planning, organizing, coordinating, and implementing strategies to effectively respond to and recover from various types of disasters. Disasters can be natural, such as earthquakes, hurricanes, floods, and wildfires, or they can be human-made, including industrial accidents, terrorist attacks, and technological failures. The goal of disaster management is to reduce the impact of disasters on human lives, property, and the environment through preparedness, response, recovery, and mitigation efforts.





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1. **Mitigation:** This phase involves taking actions to prevent or reduce the impact of disasters. It includes activities such as land-use planning, building code enforcement, and implementing early warning systems. The goal is to minimize vulnerabilities and enhance community resilience.
2. **Preparedness:** This phase focuses on planning and training to ensure that individuals, communities, and organizations are ready to respond effectively when a disaster occurs. Preparedness includes developing emergency plans, conducting drills, stockpiling supplies, and educating the public about what to do during an emergency.
3. **Response:** When a disaster strikes, the response phase involves immediate actions to save lives, protect property, and meet basic human needs. Emergency services, first responders, and organizations activate their plans to provide assistance, medical care, shelter, and other vital services.
4. **Recovery:** After the immediate response, the recovery phase aims to restore normalcy and rebuild affected communities. This phase involves assessing damage, providing long-term medical care, rebuilding infrastructure, and offering psychological support to survivors.
5. **Risk Reduction:** This ongoing phase involves continued efforts to reduce future disaster risks. It includes incorporating lessons learned from past disasters into planning and mitigation strategies, as well as raising awareness about disaster risks in the community.

Conducting a fire demonstration as part of a college disaster management event can be a highly effective way to educate students and staff about fire safety and response procedures.

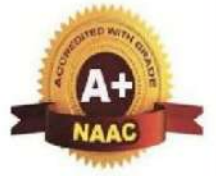
A number of students and staff were involved with this disaster management team and the entire management had been excellent. Also, this way all the students could understand various remedies relating to disaster management.

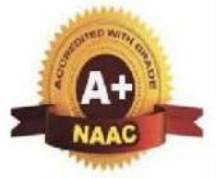
Objectives of the College ELC-

- ✓ To develop a culture of electoral participation and ethical voting and follow the principle 'Every vote counts' and 'No Voter to be Left Behind'.



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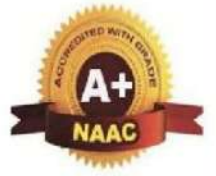
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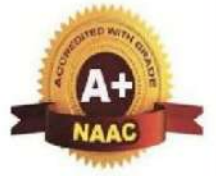
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'Swacchata Hi Sewa' Cleanliness Campaign (01 Oct 2023)

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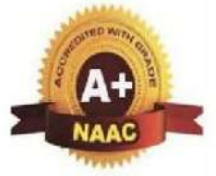
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'Vividh Gun Gaurav Puraskar'
