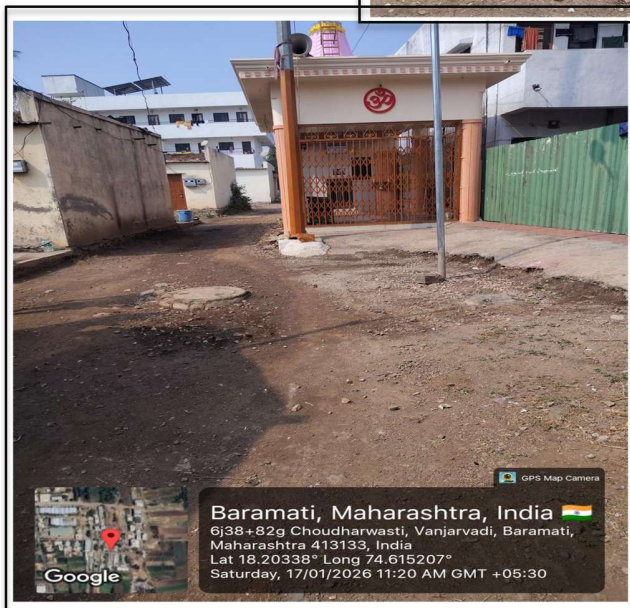
Day 2 – Campus Cleanliness Drive
