#### 1. Welcome and Opening Remarks

The meeting commenced with a welcome address to all the Honorable members of the Governing Body. The agenda of the meeting was presented, and the quorum was confirmed.

#### 2. Institute Profile and Academic Overview

The Acting Principal presented the institute profile, including academic programs, faculty profile, accreditation status, research activities, and major institutional achievements through a presentation made by Dean Academic Prof. Dr. S. M. Bhosle. The Governing Body noted the progress made by the institute in implementing academic autonomy and NEP-2020 recommendations.

#### 3. Admissions Status

The status of First Year admissions for the academic year was presented, highlighting the overall intake, admissions under CAP quota, institute quota, and EWS quota across all undergraduate programs. The Governing Body reviewed the admission statistics.

#### 4. Financial Budget and FRA Approval

The proposed budget and fee structure for UG and PG programs for the academic year 2025-26 were presented for review. The members discussed the financial planning and budget utilization.

#### 5. Students' Placement Status

The placement statistics for recent academic years were presented. The Governing Body appreciated the consistent placement performance across departments and the efforts of the Training and Placement Cell.

#### 6. Curriculum Structure and Academic Reforms

The proposed curriculum structures for Final Year (2023 Pattern) were presented as an example case. The Governing Body reviewed the curriculum in line with NEP-2020 guidelines, including provisions for internships, electives, research methodology, and skill-based courses.

### **7. Academic Results Review**

Academic results of students for the academic year 2024-25 (Semester II), 2025-26 (Semester I) were presented and discussed.

### **8. Implementation of SPPU Circular and Academic Policies**

The implementation of SPPU Provisional Admission Circular No. 209/2025 and policies related to credit transfer, course equivalence, and academic flexibility were presented and noted by the members.

### **09. Academic Calendar**

The Academic Calendar for A.Y. 2025-26 (Semester I & II) was presented and reviewed by the Governing Body.

### **10. Institutional Achievements and Initiatives**

Achievements of students in national competitions such as Smart India Hackathon, faculty development programs, industry collaborations, research activities, and extracurricular achievements were presented. The Governing Body appreciated these initiatives.

- **Hon. Pratap G. Pawar Saheb** suggested that the agenda, and financial budget of the Governing Body meeting should be circulated to all members in advance to enable detailed review and effective discussion during the meeting.
- **Hon. Yugendra Pawar** suggested that while presenting academic results and performance analysis, proper comparative analysis should be carried out on an “Apple-to-Apple” basis so that results are compared under similar parameters for better clarity and interpretation.
- **Dr. Devidas Waydande**, University Nominee, appreciated the efforts of the institute in effectively implementing academic autonomy and aligning its academic processes with the guidelines of the National Education Policy (NEP-2020). He commended the institute for maintaining strong academic standards, adopting innovative teaching-learning practices, and encouraging student participation in research, internships, and online certification courses such as NPTEL and SWAYAM. He also appreciated the initiatives taken towards strengthening industry–academia collaboration, promoting outcome-based education, and enhancing overall student development.

The institute agreed to incorporate these suggestions in future presentations and governance practices.

*(Effective from 26/11/2020)*

This policy outlines the guidelines for acceptance, evaluation, and academic recognition of NPTEL (National Learning Innovation for Knowledge Empowerment) courses. The process is designed after consultation with the academic heads of VIJVA. Learning for learning benefit only and meeting credit hour requirements.

**APPLICABILITY:** This policy applies to:

- All VJVA students of VIJVA who are pursuing B.Tech. programs.
- Courses approved by the member institutions (Member Institutions) for credit transfer.
- NPTEL courses approved by the member institutions (Member Institutions).

**NPTEL'S COURSE EVALUATION STRUCTURE:** Like courses are evaluated using the following criteria:

- Self-paced/online learning structure.
- Content and Depth of Assessment.
- Rigor of Faculty Based Assignments.
- Final Exam/Assignment (Skill or evaluation test).

The overall performance achieved in the evaluation process is used as the official NPTEL's final certificate.
